

Ptak on "ERP, Tools, Techniques, and Applications for Integrating the Supply Chain," and with Dr. Goldratt and Carol A. Ptak on "Necessary But Not Sufficient." In March 2009, a new book titled "Supply Chain Fulfillment at Warp Speed," with H. William Dettmer and Wayne Patterson was published. The new book contains much of the new developments of TOC in operations. Mr. Schragenheim holds an MBA from Tel Aviv University, Israel, and a BSc in Mathematics and Physics from the Hebrew University in Jerusalem.

H. William Dettmer is a professional management consultant.
