Costas Panagopoulos is Professor of Political Science and Director of the Center for Electoral Politics and Democracy and the graduate program in Elections and Campaign Management at Fordham University. A leading expert on campaigns and elections, voting behavior, media and public opinion, political psychology

and campaign finance, Professor Panagopoulos has co-authored or edited several books, including *Politicking Online: The Transformation of Election Campaigns Communications* (Rutgers University Press) and *Public Financing in American Elections* (Temple University Press). He has published over 60 scholarly articles in outlets including the *American Journal of Political Science*, the *Journal of Politics*, *Public Opinion Quarterly*, *Political Behavior*, *Political Psychology* and *Political Analysis*. He has also served as Editor-in-Chief of *Campaigns & Elections* magazine, as Senior Editor of the *Journal of Political Marketing*, and as part of the NBC News Decision Desk team since the 2006 election cycle.
